

With that being said, we hope that our BI families are having a safe, smooth, and successful transition back to school.

Day Program Information & Schedule

We are excited to share some information about some updates we have made with the Day Program! Each child has an individualized treatment plan that is developed and supervised by Board Certified Behavior Analyst/Clinical Supervisor. They are assigned to a Registered Behavior Technician (RBT) who works with them throughout the program. The program incorporates different activities where the kids get to transition throughout the day, which makes the learning process fun and interactive for our kiddos. These activities include:

- Imaginative play
- Reading
- Building
- Art
- Writing
- Circle Time

- Tabletime
- Music
- Outdoor Activities
- Playground
- Independent Living Skills



Once the child is mastering goals, we move to a 3:1 ratio to foster independence. Although the shadow has faded out, they are still in the environment to provide assistance when needed.
